- Players will not engage in unsportsmanlike conduct including fighting, use of profanity, stealing and damaging properties.
- Players will not engage in rude behavior on or off the field.
- Players will treat everyone, including coaches, parents, players and officials with respect regardless of race, creed, color, nationality or gender.
- Players should feel safe to report known violations by contacting any one of the Executive Staff without fear of retaliation.

When violation(s) is reported to the coach or Executive Staff, we will conduct a review of the situation and will make the final determination of what action, if any, may be appropriate. If action is necessary, the available options range from a caution or warning, to requiring a personal apology, probation, service work, suspension from playing or attending games, a hearing to determine the relevant facts of the violation, or as a final step, expulsion from WE Surf SC in accordance with the club Code of Conduct policy.
